

## KEYS TO GRAHAM COOKE'S SATURDAY EVENING MESSAGE 2018 US NATIONAL CONFERENCE

- **Key:** Fighting from our position as a joint heir with Christ lifts us out of the world's economic system into the place of Kingdom provision.
- **Key:** Promises are given so that we can discover the power in God's relationship with His people.
- **Key:** In the Majesty of His Righteousness towards us God can only see us in the right way.
- **Key:** You always know where you stand with God because He is unchanging toward you.
- **Key:** God's covenant is with Christ who lives within us.
- **Key:** His promises become our permission to believe.
- **Key:** As His people we do not navigate through our life by problems, by crises, or by chaos; we navigate life through the promises and the prophecies that God has given us.
- **Key:** One of the laws of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus is that no problem comes by itself; it has to come with promises, provision, or prophecy.
- **Key:** God rules in our life by promise.
- **Key:** We are persuaded by promises just like Abraham was.
- **Key:** The whole art of walking with God is that you believe the same thing about yourself that He believes about you. You are on the same page all the time.
- **Key:** God does not ask you to deny a negative situation, He asks you to consider the promises concerning the situation instead.
- **Key:** Promises highlight the faithfulness of God to you and come so you have a place to partner with Him through the situation.
- **Key:** Keep your eye on the promise that is filled with possibilities, not the negative situation.
- **Key:** Never give a problem more power than a promise.
- **Key:** Being a joint heir with Christ is connected to our confidence in God's complete goodness toward us.
- **Key:** Challenges are a gateway into a greater experience of God's Goodness.
- **Key:** There is no situation, no reviling that can come into your life that does not have a blessing attached.
- **Key:** Be awestruck by who God wants to be for you in every situation that arises.
- **Key:** Promises create a tender expectation that cause us to get another thought.

- **Key:** Once you have a promise or a prophetic word, you bring that before the Lord, not the problem.
- **Key:** Evil can never challenge us. We can only be challenged by the Goodness of God.
- **Key:** To lead effectively, we must keep ourselves grounded in the truths God has been pouring into us that cause us to be a prepared people who are preparing people.
- **Key:** Personally and corporately, we must know by experience the fullness of God's heart toward us.
